Claims and reimbursement forms must be submitted during current academic year as per following timeframe:

- Conferences and courses July 1<sup>st</sup> to March 15<sup>th</sup> (as per fiscal year guideline)
- BCSS Annual Meeting after the event

Failure to meet the above criteria may result in ineligibility for reimbursement.

## **REIMBURSEMENT PROCESS**

The following conditions apply (consistent with UBC PGME Finance and Travel Guidelines):

- 1. Request for time off to present at a conference or attend a conference/course **must be approved** by the service that you are rotating on.
- 2. Request for conference reimbursement if presenting (up to \$1,000) **must be approved** by the Program Co-Directors. Other requests **must be approved** by the Program.
- 3. **Conference Travel Reimbursement Form** must be completed, signed and emailed to Program with electronic receipts attached.

## Notes:

- Airline itinerary-receipt should show the dates, breakdown of cost and form of payment. Airline tickets must be booked in advance at the lowest rate.
- When possible, residents are encouraged to share accommodations.
- Residents **presenting at a conference** are required to provide a copy of confirmation of acceptance for presentation or the conference program indicating their name and presentation.

Failure to meet the above criteria may result in ineligibility for reimbursement.
